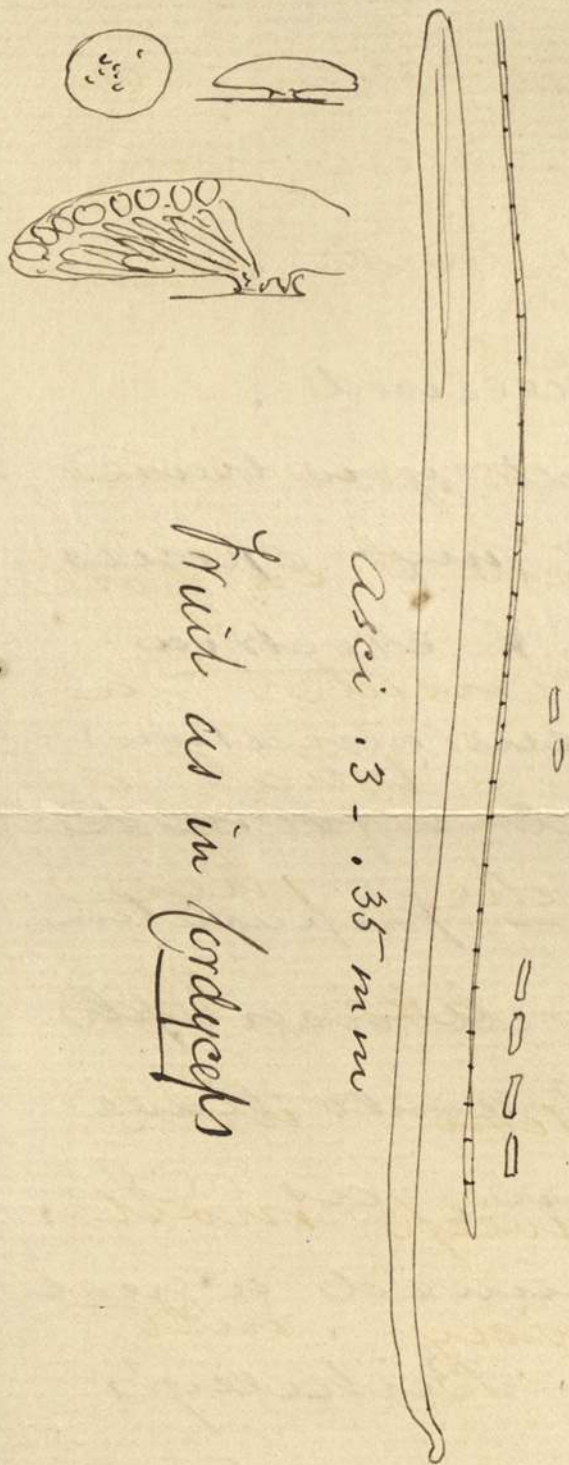


My dear Sir

*Hypocrea scutata*




Asci .3 - .35 mm
