The *Nectria* on *Brassica* does
not seem to agree with
the characters of any species
described as far as I see

Nectria Brassica N.S.
Perithecia densely gregarious
ovate .004' high.

Asci clavate-cylind. .0022' x
.0003' Spores ovate obl.
constricted uniseptate
.0003' - .0004' x .00015'
conidia lunate uniseptate

I have not yet
recd. Cent XIV *Mycotheca*
Veneta.
