No. 50 seems to me to be a
nov. gen. Nectriaceae

Stroma subgelatinous when fresh,

$\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ mm. diam. Perithecia buried

in the stroma, 4-6 in a stroma

80-100 μ diam, ostiolum papillyform

Asci cylind. 40-60 x 7-8

Spor. fusoid-oblong, 1-septate,
hyaline, 12-15 x 3

Perhaps better in the Dothideaceae

215 looks like Aecidium but does
not appear in reality to be that
