

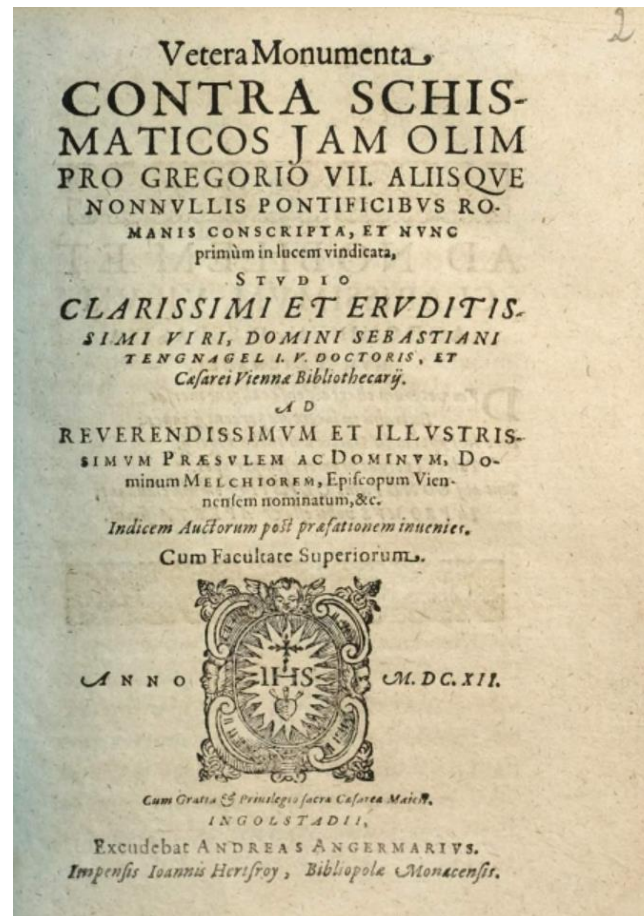



Early modern correspondence has been the object of digital research for many years, and still there are no ready-made solutions for data archiving and data publication. The paper presents a dataset based on the correspondence and manuscript collection of Vienna court librarian Sebastian Tengnagel (d. 1636) and discusses the structure and potential interconnectedness of the respective TEI XML files. With repositories like correspSearch or EMLO already in place, the question of which data to store, which data to make available, and which data to publish by way of a GUI becomes a crucial issue to be discussed among researchers and repository representatives.



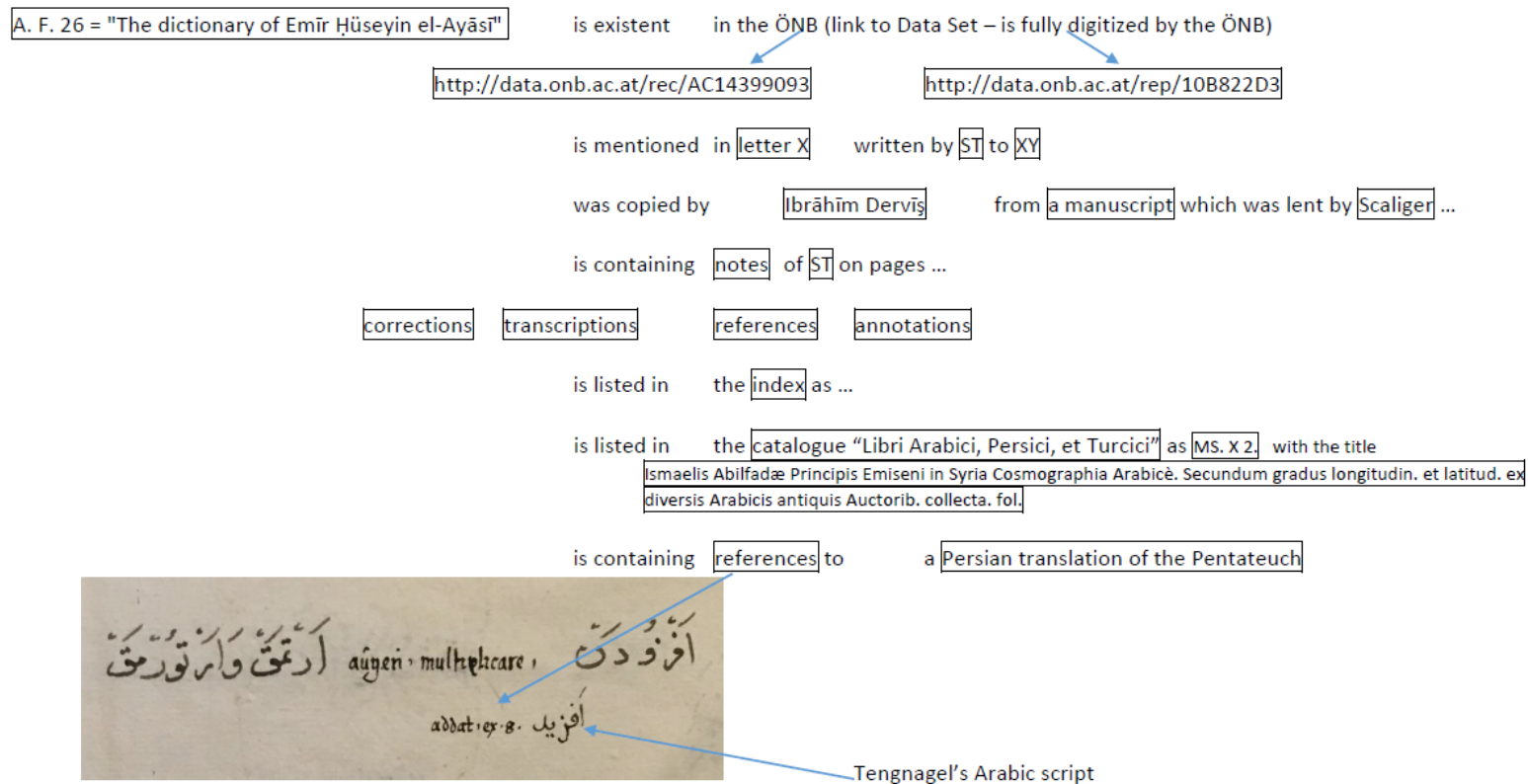
