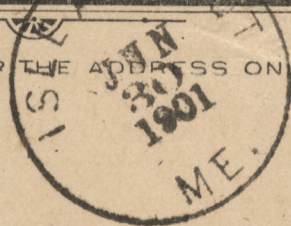
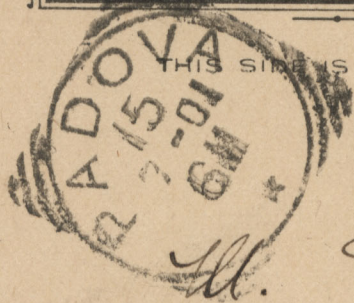
My Dear Sir: -
