OF SAN JUAN REGION DURING 1899.

St. Croix Falls, Wis., March 9, 1899

Dear Sir:--

The field work in the Southern Rocky Mountains carried on in the LaPlata Region in 1898, will this year be extended into the San Juan Region - the extreme eastern extension of the Great Basin watershed in S.W. Colorado and N.W. New Mexico. Last year the field work was limited to a month, and the plants were determined and issued under difficulties. However, they included many new Phanerogams (in *Amelanchier*, *Thelypodium*, *Draba*, *Gilia*, *Lupinus*, *Ranunculus*, *Castilleja*, etc), while a third of the Fungi were new. These sets went to herbaria of Edinburgh, Kew, Berlin, New York, Washington, Chicago, St. Louis, and others. A full report on the 1898 work by Dr. Greene and Prof. Earle will soon be out.

This year the field work will continue through the entire season, and be done thoroughly and critically up to 13000 feet altitude. Judging from previous work, the plants for 1899 promise results of unusual interest and importance. The value of the Phanerogams will be greatly augmented by pass- through Dr. Greene's hands before issuance. The sets entire will be issued from the Catholic Univ. in Washington. The probable number of new forms and the care with which specimens will be selected prepared and determined, will make these sets indispensable to all herbaria. A full report of results will be published as for 1898, and issued free to subscribers.

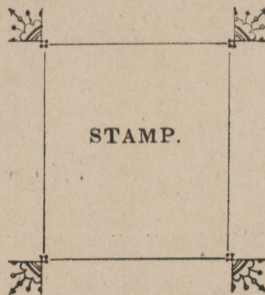
