Your *Peziza* with  
apiculate sporidia is  
*Peziza* (*Cupulares*) *apiculata*. C  
(*Mycographia* part IV. ined.)  
It is the same with specimen  
from *Lucca* - communicated  
by C. E. Broome

- *Peziza* in *Calidarius*  
*Hort. Patavia* *glabra*!  
is *species nova*. This  
I have called *Peziza*  
*tincturella*

- *Peziza* *repanda* ?  
is not that species

but - as I think -  
undescribed. I have  
named it Peziza  
(Cupulares) Saccardoii

- The Peziza sent  
previously as Peziza  
humosa ? is allied  
to Peziza Carstii  
but (apparently)  
a distinct species

What was the color  
of the disc in this  
last ? - an rubro,  
coccineo vel luteo ??

I shall have pleasure  
in writing you again  
upon Sphaeria culmicolae  
but I have many  
specimens to examine

Sphaeria nigra Desmz  
(see specim: original) is  
quite distinct from  
S. culmifraga &c &c and  
a good species
