

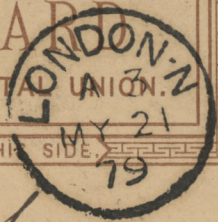
Your Peziza n<sup>o</sup> 2 certainly appears  
to be the same with specimens in  
the Kew Herbarium from Persoon  
under the name of P. lentiformis  
under which name I have figure  
prepared for elycographia. It  
cannot be referred to any other  
species if the sporidia are  
smooth when mature. As  
Mr Phillips has examined  
Persoon's specimens I also  
referred yours to him - and  
he confirms my opinion that  
it is P. lentiformis Pers. I  
do not know if Persoon has  
anywhere described it
