"*Hobsonia* Berk. in herb. Sporodochia verruciformia, superficialia; conidia uncoinita numerosa, cylindracea, hyalina, in tubum spiritaliter laxo conooluta, pluriverticillata."

"*H. rigaspora* Berk. in herb. Sporodochia ochraceis, hemisphaerica vel subinaequalibus, saepe confluentibus 2-4 um. diam.; conidia cylindraceis dense septatis articulis cuboideis, 10-11 se diam., hyalina in spiris 4-6 laxo conoolutis tubulosis oblongum 70-80 x 35-40 se formentibus in culm. & bambos. Venezuela."

Horny & contracted when dry. *Eretharta* differs in having the multiseptate conidia wound in one plane; & *Troposporium* in the aseptate conidia being tightly wound. 4 »
