

I have no duplicate examples of Vol I Bulletin Buffalo Soc. Nat. Sci. in which, in 1873, at pp. 41-72, were published descriptions of several new species, but these same descriptions are in Reports 25 and 26 with "Peck" added to the botanical name as author. These descriptions can as well be taken from these two Reports.

A few other descriptions of which I have no duplicates I send transcribed with pen.

Descriptions of Uncinula macrospora Peck, Uncinula Clintonii Peck and Uncinula Ampelopsidis Peck (Trans. Albany Inst. Vol. VII pp 215 & 216, 1872) can be found in 25th Report p. 96.
