My Dear Colleague:

The description of the Glomerularia was in the 32nd Report, but the Government was so economical, that it did not publish that Report except as a public document and I could get only one copy of it. I am therefore unable to distribute it. I do not regard it as a valid publication, and expect to have the new species ^{in it} republished soon. Will then send to you copies. I send manuscript description of the Glomerularia. It is a curious fungus, and I scarcely know where it belongs.

I inclose a fungus which
attacks the petioles of *Vaccinium*
Pennsylvanicum and kills the
leaves. I am in doubt if
it is *Oospora* or *Oidium*
Where would you place it?
