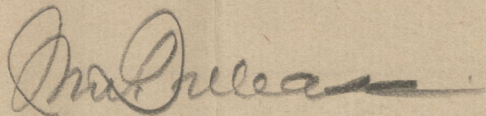
Dear Professor Saccardo:
