correspondence with your northern neighbors, so
I have no knowledge of the effects of the war
upon mycological activity in Germany & Austria.

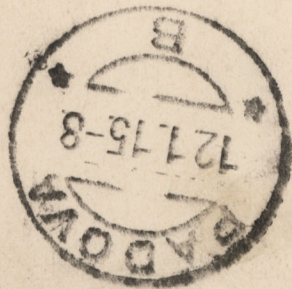

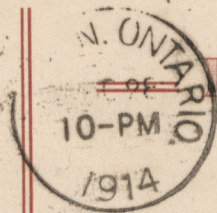
