To the Curator.

Dear Sir.

We understand that you have in your gardens a number of Sinko biloba (Maidenhair) trees. We want you to get us some of the Pollen, and also young Embryos.

Please put a number of the male flowers & a few female flowers into the ~~Bottle~~ marked no 1, & leave them for about 12 hours. They should be cut direct from the tree & dropped into the bottle as quickly as possible then pour off the solution & fill up the Bottle with solution marked no 2, taking care not to lose the pollen.

If you can do the same with Cycas Revoluta pollen & Embryos please do so. Keeping them separate from the Sinko.

Should you be unable to do the above for us please let us know where we can obtain the Pollen &c required.
