Die gewünschte Diagnose lautet: *Epirocium torquens* Massal. in
Torrey VI, 49 (1903) 4 fig. - Stromata almost circular, convex, isolated
or sometimes more or less confluent, about 350 μ diam., brownish;
conidia globose, sessile, 1-celled, brown, minutely wrinkled, 15-20 μ diam.;
conidiophores sparingly branched, septate; springing from the compact
peripheral cells of the stroma. - ~~At~~ *Aspergillus* *Heisia viridula*
prope Thomsenville Ga. (coll. Mrs. A. L. Taylor). - Allied most nearly to
E. aschmannii Link., in having beaked conidia; differing most in the larger
polygonal cells composing the stroma, the much larger, branched, septate

antiophores, and finally
is parasitic habit.
