My Dear Sir,

I have just received your Post-card
request to reply. All my publications are supposed
to be sent to you, but evidently some of them
you have not received. At the risk of duplication
I send you all the Decades published I-VIII
& a work on the Diseases of Stone Fruit Trees published
in 1902.

1. You will find Phyllosticta stenospora in
Descriptions of new Australian Fungi at p. 105 & the
name corrected in Decades III-IV at p. 103
2. The diagnosis of Phyllosticta microspora M. Alp. nec. C. G. S.
is given in Stone Fruit Diseases at p. 108, but
as I have not published any correction, you can
alter the name as you think best.
3. In Decades I-II at p. 377 I have also described
a Phoma passiflorae & on account of the name
being pre-occupied, I have suggested the name
Macrophoma passiflorae in Decades III-IV p. 103.
The issue of your Col. XVIII is awaited with great
interest.
