Enclosed you will find a leaf spot con. *Ulmus Americana*. This fungus I have provisionally called *Phyllosticta ulmicola*. Sacc. Mich. Ep. 198.

I would like to get your opinion on this specimen, and also if possible a specimen of your *Phyllosticta ulmicola*.

I find a considerable quantity of this fungus on the elms here and in some cases causes rather badly diseased leaves. in some cases destroying nearly half the leaf.
